## 10<sup>TH</sup> BIENNIAL CONFERENCE OF THE CZECH ECONOMIC SOCIETY

### PRAGUE, 1<sup>ST</sup> DECEMBER 2018

The Czech Economic Society invites submissions from all fields of economics and finance for its 10<sup>th</sup> biennial conference to be held at the University of Economics, Prague, in Prague, Czech Republic, on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018.

The conference is organised in cooperation with the University of Economics, Prague, and the Czech National Bank. It is supported by the Council of Scientific Societies of the Czech Republic. This year's conference commemorates the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the creation of Czechoslovakia and the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Czech Republic. It will be preceded by a workshop on the occasion of 20 years of inflation targeting to be held at the Czech National Bank on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018.

Presenters may be asked to serve as discussants. Decisions on acceptance or rejection will be sent out by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2018.
